ACADEMIC YEAR 2024–2025

INTRODUCTION

Vidya Prasarak Mandal's Thane Municipal Council Law College, Thane, has always stayed firmly committed to social justice, legal awareness, and active community involvement through its energetic Legal Aid Cell. From the very beginning of the college, this Cell has served as a key platform that turns legal education into real and meaningful action for society. It works not just as a required academic duty but as a strong connection between legal knowledge and the urgent needs of society—especially for disadvantaged, poor, and legally unaware people.

Following the constitutional duty of equal access to justice and legal aid as stated in Article 39A of the Indian Constitution, the college set up a dedicated Legal Aid Office in 2012. Since that time, the Cell has steadily grown in reach, activities, and influence. It works closely with the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), Thane, and carries out many legal awareness, outreach, and support programmes throughout the year. Legal aid work is now a formal part of the students' practical training, making sure every student gets direct experience in community-focused legal service.

In the 2024–2025 academic year, the Legal Aid Cell saw outstanding involvement from students across all years of the LL.B. course. Beyond required fieldwork, many students willingly took part in awareness campaigns, and several served actively as Para Legal Volunteers, helping with basic legal empowerment at the grassroots level. The ongoing encouragement and strong support from VPM Management, Principal Dr. Srividhya Jayakumar, faculty coordinators, and particularly the District Legal Services Authority, Thane, were crucial in making these efforts successful.

ABOUT THE COLLEGE LEGAL AID CELL

The College Legal Aid Cell operates directly from the campus of Vidya Prasarak Mandal's Thane Municipal Council Law College, Thane. To keep things organised and easily reachable for students and those who need help, the college has created a separate Legal Aid Cell office/room inside the campus. This dedicated space, running since 2012, acts as the main centre for all legal aid and awareness work done by the college.

The office serves as a central point where planning, record-keeping, reporting, and follow-up of legal aid activities happen under the guidance of faculty

coordinators. It is set up to support student meetings, talks with people seeking help, creation of awareness materials, keeping of records, and contact with outside bodies like the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), Thane. Having this permanent office on campus guarantees steady progress, clear responsibility, and long-term memory of all legal aid efforts.

The Cell stays active throughout the academic year and is always open for students who need advice on legal aid work, para-legal volunteering, fieldwork planning, or community programmes. It also acts as a first contact point for people looking for basic legal guidance, referrals, or information about free legal help and remedies. Through this well-structured system, the Legal Aid Cell makes sure its work is regular, organised, and fully matched with the larger goal of access to justice.

OBJECTIVES OF THE LEGAL AID CELL ACTIVITIES

The Legal Aid Cell at VPM's TMC Law College follows clear goals that match the constitutional promise of justice and equality. A main goal is to spread legal knowledge and awareness among ordinary people, particularly those who have no access to formal legal education. By explaining laws in simple, local terms, the Cell helps people understand and claim their rights and duties.

Another key goal is to give students hands-on learning that goes far beyond classroom teaching. Through direct community work, students see how laws work in real life and how awareness can stop exploitation, injustice, and abuse. The Cell also aims to build strong ethical values, empathy, and leadership, teamwork, and communication skills in students, shaping them into socially aware legal professionals.

The Legal Aid Cell further supports national and state efforts on child protection, women's safety, digital security, environmental care, health, education, and social welfare. By focusing activities on current issues like cybercrime, drug abuse, sexual offences, workplace harassment, environmental damage, and civic duties, the Cell stays relevant and quick to respond to society's challenges.

ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMMES CONDUCTED DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024–2025: CHRONOLOGICAL ACCOUNT

Throughout the 2024–2025 academic year, the Legal Aid Cell of VPM's Thane Municipal Council Law College worked in a planned, organized, and ongoing way. All activities were designed to keep society engaged all year and to give students steady, growing experience, strengthening both outreach and practical learning.

The year started in August 2024 with school-based awareness sessions on child protection and safety. Early programmes took place in municipal and private schools, reaching primary and secondary students with clear messages on child safety, bodily autonomy, and rights under the Protection of Children from Sexual

Offences Act, 2012. Using simple explanations, pictures, posters, and interactive talks, children learned about safe and unsafe touch, trusted adults, and the need to report worrying situations. These opening activities-built trust and created strong connections with young learners. Our students have visited almost 100+ educational institutions in Thane, Mumbai and Navi Mumbai areas.

In September and October 2024, the Cell stepped up efforts on cyber law awareness due to rising online fraud and exploitation. Several programmes reached students from classes V to XII, junior college learners, and community members. Sessions covered threats like phishing, OTP scams, fake loan apps, digital arrest frauds, online impersonation, cyberbullying, and social media misuse. Laws from the Information Technology Act, 2000, and related criminal sections were explained clearly. Practical tips on safe online habits, reporting steps, and prevention were shared. Some of these efforts gained attention in local newspapers, showing their wide reach and importance.

From November to December 2024, the Cell ran programmes on constitutional awareness in schools and colleges. Students in classes VIII to X learned about the Preamble, Fundamental Rights, Fundamental Duties, and constitutional remedies. By linking these values to daily life, participants gained a stronger sense of equality, freedom, dignity, and civic duty. The sessions promoted democratic ideals and stressed the importance of balancing rights with responsibilities for good citizenship.

In the same period, a full awareness programme was held in Karjat Taluka at Shri Gajanan Vidyalaya, Kadav. Students in classes IX and X were taught about Fundamental Rights, the POCSO Act, child labour laws, and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009. Special focus was given to the constitutional right to education and the legal results of stopping schooling. This effort raised legal understanding among rural students and highlighted their legal protections.

Between January and February 2025, the Cell organised programmes on social and health-related legal topics. Awareness sessions on drug abuse and prevention were held in schools, colleges, and coaching centres. These covered laws on narcotic substances, the serious harm of drugs to body and mind, and the lasting damage to studies and social life. Students joined lively discussions on peer pressure, personal responsibility, and smart choices.

At the same time, the Cell held workplace-focused sessions on the Prevention of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act, 2013, for employees in various professional places. Topics included legal requirements, duties of employers and staff, complaint processes, and the need for a safe, respectful workplace. Real examples helped everyone see how the law works in practice.

In March and April 2025, environmental legal awareness became a major focus. Students gave talks on laws protecting water and air, controlling noise pollution, safeguarding wildlife and forests, and constitutional duties toward the environment. Input from National Disaster Response Force members added real-world knowledge on disaster management and ecological balance. This work powerfully connected legal awareness with environmental responsibility and civic action.

From May to July 2025, the Cell concentrated on direct community outreach at the grassroots level. Door-to-door campaigns and village programmes addressed property rights, women's and children's rights, legal solutions, and access to justice. Sessions in villages like Khaire Ambivali brought law students face-to-face with rural residents, who gratefully received legal guidance right in their own area.

At the same time, special programmes targeted street vendors and informal workers on the Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014. Vendors learned their rights, protection from illegal eviction, and ways to challenge wrongful seizure of goods. Separate sessions in cooperative banks and credit societies covered cyber fraud prevention, financial caution, and legal rules.

All through the year, the Cell carefully documented activities, followed up, and reviewed progress through student reports, faculty oversight, and college records. This step-by-step approach ensured ongoing, inclusive, and lasting social benefit.

OUTCOME AND IMPACT OF LEGAL AID CELL ACTIVITIES

The overall results of the Legal Aid Cell's work in 2024–2025 were deep and wide-ranging. For the community, the programmes sharply raised legal awareness, gave people power to know and demand their rights, and built a strong habit of preventing legal problems. Children grew bolder in speaking about safety, young people became safer and wiser online, workers understood their workplace rights, and vulnerable groups gained vital legal knowledge.

For students, the Cell provided a powerful learning experience. Taking part improved their public speaking, communication, leadership, teamwork, and research abilities. They learned to turn complicated laws into clear, everyday language and felt the real reward of helping bring social change. Many students said they gained greater confidence, a clearer view of law in action, and a stronger feeling of professional duty.

The activities also deepened the college's ties with society and strengthened its image as a truly responsive institution. Coverage of some programmes in

newspapers like Navbharat Times and Mumbai Kiran further showed the strong reach and value of these efforts.

CONCLUSION The Legal Aid Cell of VPM's Thane Municipal Council Law College, Thane, continues to play an essential role in advancing access to justice, legal awareness, and social empowerment. The academic year 2024–2025 clearly demonstrates the Cell's firm dedication to inclusive, powerful, and continuing legal outreach. With ongoing backing from management, faculty, and legal authorities, the Legal Aid Cell remains committed to developing socially responsible lawyers and making a real contribution to justice and equality in society.

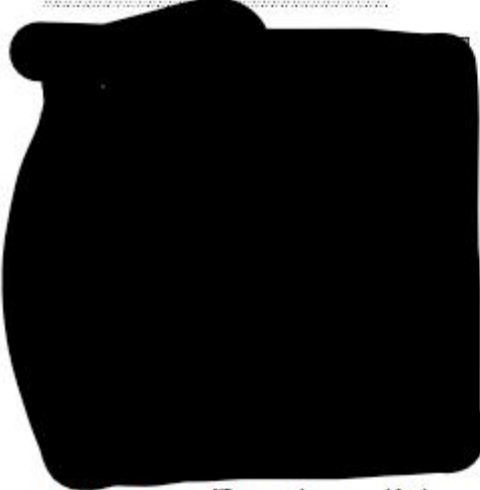

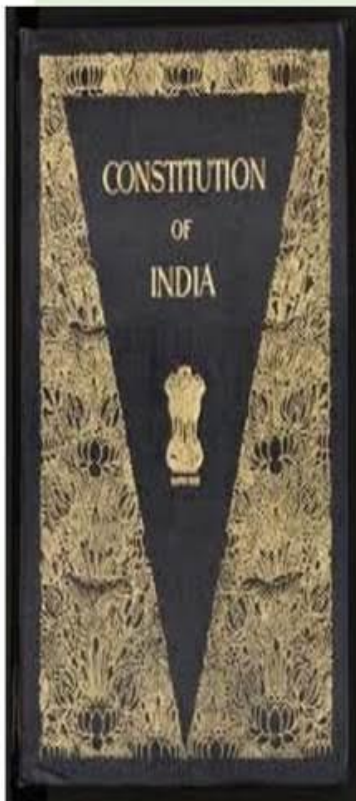
